# A Winning Attitude

1 Samuel 17:1-58

**What was David's winning strategy?**

**1. It began with his UNDERSTANDING about God.**

- A. He saw God as greater than any person or situation.  
Vs 25-26
- B. He identified himself with God and he was confident in God's covenant relationship with His people. Vs26
- C. He was confident in what God would do through him.  
Vs 32-37
- D. His goal was that the world might know there is a God in heaven. Vs 45-47

**2. David's MOTIVE was to uphold God's honor and glory.**

- A. David said to Goliath, "I come against you in the name of the Lord Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel whom you have defied." Vs 5
- B. David said to Goliath, "I want the whole world to know there is a God in Israel. Vs 46-47

**3. David's ATTITUDE was that nothing is impossible with God.**

- A. When David saw Goliath he saw a problem and wanted to be part of the solution. Vs 32
- B. When David saw Goliath he also saw an opportunity.
- C. When David saw Goliath he saw a way to give courage, faith and victory for all Israel. Vs 47
