- 1. How do we distinguish between the will of God and an opportunity for sin? 1 Samuel 24**
  - A. The will of God can never be separated from the Word of God. 1 Samuel 24:1-7 Proverbs 24:29
  - B. Opportunity is not a green light but a time of decision.
  
- 2. What does the decision to choose the will of God say about us? 1 Samuel 24:12-15**
  - A. We are not evil.
  - B. We are trusting God rather than our own judgment.
  
- 3. What are the rewards for doing the right thing? 1 Samuel 24:16-22 Proverbs 16:7**
  - A. Saul acknowledged that David was righteous.
  - B. Saul reaffirms what God had already promised that David would one day be king.
