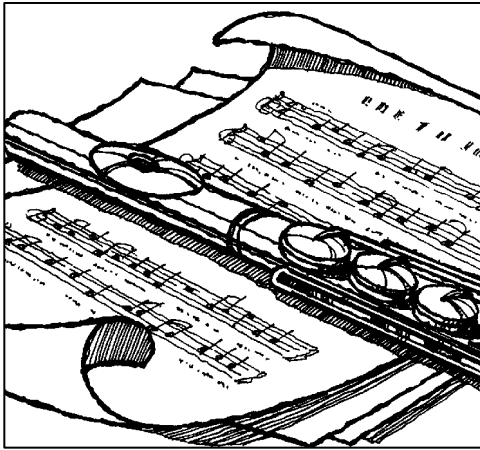

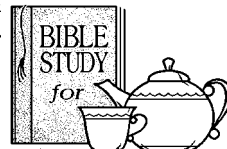

there is still Hope***

1 Samuel 28

1 Chronicles 10:13-14

“Saul died because he was unfaithful to the Lord, He even consulted a medium and did not inquire of the Lord.”

Setting the stage...

1. David is on the side of the Philistines. Vs 1-2

2. Samuel is dead. Vs 3

3. All mediums and spiritists are expelled from Israel.

1. God may not respond to us because we want God’s help while maintaining our own independence.

1 Samuel 28:4-6 1 Chronicles 10:13-14

2. God may not respond to us because we seek answers but not always from God. 1 Samuel 28:7-14

Deuteronomy 18:10-13 Leviticus 19:26 Isaiah 8:19

John 8:44

3. God may not respond to us because we refuse to repent of our willful sin. 1 Samuel 28:15-25

Samuel outlines why Saul does not hear from God...

1. The Lord has done what He said He would do.

2. The kingdom has been torn from Saul and given to David.

3. This happened because Saul did not obey God’s command.

4. Saul & his sons would die and Israel would be defeated by the Philistines. 1 Samuel 31
